We'll meet there.

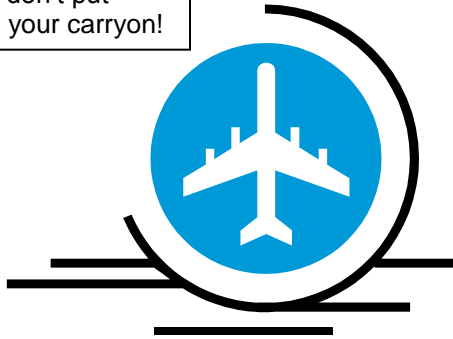

- The pool might be open so be prepared with appropriate swim wear.



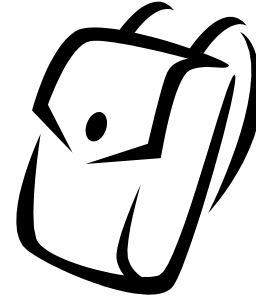

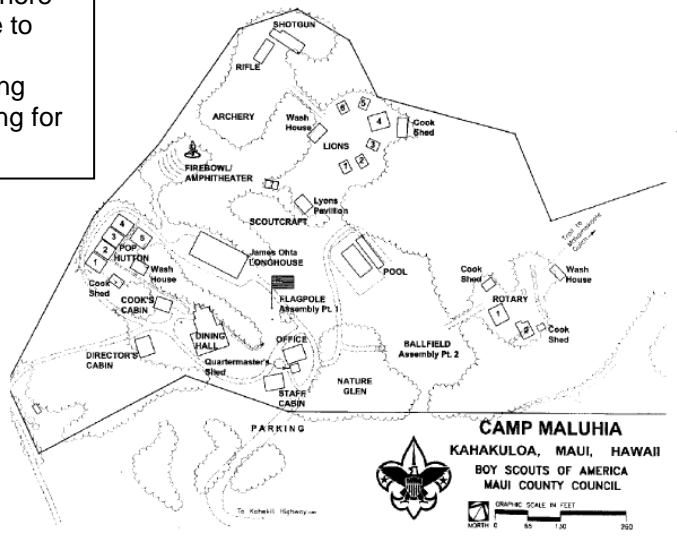
Earn the Conclave Participation award! It's a free patch only for those who complete all the requirements for the Conclave Participation award (CPA).

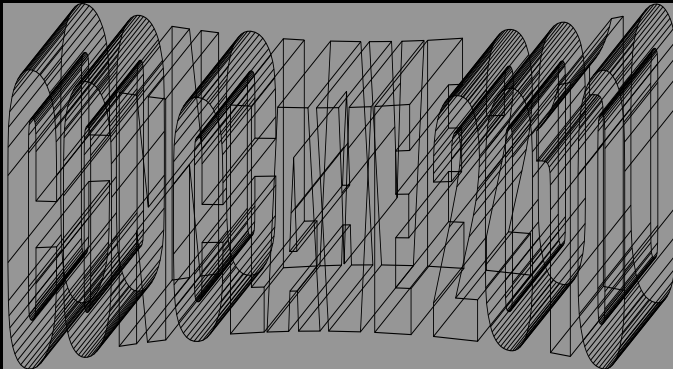
